	The application must be complete, signed and dated. If your attachments are too large, you must complete your application with an online sharing link (Google Drive, WeTransfer, Dropbox, etc.). You are allowed to submit a file even if you are Ph.D. student and the doctorate certification is not yet in your possession. In this case, it will be necessary to send proof of achievement no later than: 15 July 2025. A maximum of three applications will be allowed for each candidate. For long-term scholarships, each applicant will be eligible for a maximum of one scholarship (possibly with a renewal). However, a long-term and a short-term scholarship may be combined, as can several short-term scholarships, as long as the limit of three attempts is respected and the 3- year period between two stays is observed;

	In the event of a new application, any changes made to the previous application must be justified;
	Once the results have been communicated by WBI, the candidate will have seven calendar days to decide whether or not to accept the scholarship, so as not to disadvantage any substitute candidates.
