Call info	The IOCB Doctoral Fellowship is designed to support 2-6 months research stays of talented Ph.D. students coming to IOCB from laboratories abroad. The primary aim is to initiate or enhance collaboration between IOCB Principal Investigators (PIs) and their counterparts from foreign laboratories through this student mobility initiative.
Conditions / Restrictions	<p>Candidate has to be a Ph.D. student on a foreign university/institution. Doctoral fellowship can only be awarded once to the applicant.</p> <p>Candidate's supervisor already collaborates or intend to collaborate with a PI from IOCB as indicated in Letter of Support. The research stay must be coordinated with candidate's supervisor/institution.</p> <p>The foreign PhD student must become an employee of the IOCB Prague for the duration of his/her research stay. The group leader is responsible for providing a workplace for him/her for the duration of the stay.</p> <p>Funding of IOCB Doctoral Fellowship will be started on a rolling basis upon evaluation. The fellowship must be started within 12 months of the award committee's decision, except in cases of maternity/parental leave (18 months extension). If a later start is intended, the committee will require a new proposal to be submitted.</p> <p>Only in duly justified cases may the Commission consider approving applications in the interim period between the regular deadlines.</p> <p>Based on availability, temporary accommodation in one of the guest houses of the institute or the Czech Academy of Sciences may be offered at affordable rent.</p>

Proposal consists of	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) CV with contacts (address, e-mail, phone) (PhD student) 2) A Cover letter outlining the motivation for the application (PhD student) 3) Name of the IOCB group leader/mentor and the envisaged starting date of the fellowship (PhD student) 4) A project proposal: concise introduction, well-defined objectives, a proposed solution, an anticipated timeline, a brief risk analysis, and references to relevant literature. (max. 3 pages) (PhD student & IOCB mentor/group leader) 5) A Support Letter from the applicant's PhD supervisor at the collaborating institution (PhD student foreign supervisor) 6) A Support Letter of the IOCB group leader (IOCB group leader) <p>Applicants submit the complete application package (1–6) as a single PDF file to the IOCB mentor/group leader. Group leader will forward the application to fellowship@uochb.cas.cz.</p> <p>Further information may be found at the IOCB webpage</p> <p><u>The final report must include:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) A cover letter 2) A summary of the results as well as possible plans for further work to be undertaken. (1-2 pages)
