Call info	FEBS Summer Fellowships are awarded to young promising masters and PhD students in a FEBS country wishing to gain practical scientific experience in biochemistry and molecular biology in an institution located in another country within the FEBS area.
Conditions / Restrictions	Applicants are currently engaged in research for a master or PhD degree in biochemistry or molecular biology and have not yet submitted a doctoral thesis. Applicants are working in a laboratory in a FEBS member country and are seeking to work in a laboratory in a different FEBS member country. Applicants have never been the recipients of a FEBS Summer Fellowship. Fellowships are not awarded for attendance at courses, symposia, meetings or congresses.

Proposal consists of	The FEBS Fellowship should be acknowledged in any work published relating to the project funded and a reprint of each article should be sent electronically to the Chairperson of the Fellowships Committee. Within three months of completion of the Fellowship, recipients must send electronically to the Chairperson of the FEBS Fellowships Committee a short report detailing the work done. The author of the report judged to be the best in that year will receive a prize, which currently amounts to 500 EUR. Only one application per PI will be funded. Online application: https://fellowships.febs.org/summer_2025/registration/index/ 1) Short description of the work (max 2 A4 pages uploaded in PDF format) (applicant) 2) Short CV with a list of publications in the format required by the FEBS Journal (https://febs.onlinelibrary.wiley.com/hub/journal/17424658/journal-menu/author-quidelines#references) and a list of conference abstracts (applicant) 3) Host acceptance form on official form downloadable from the application system (head & supervisor of the host institution) 4) Referee letter as a letterheaded document: opinion on applicant's practical skills, scientific curiosity, dedication, strong/weak points and degree of maturity (referee from the institution where the applicant has worked or studied) The document "Writing a successful fellowship or grant application" https://febs.onlinelibrary.wiley.com/doi/10.1111/febs.14318 provides essential guidance for successful grant writing, crafting compelling proposals, and highlights key elements such as clear objectives, a well-organized research plan, and an understanding of evaluation criteria to maximize the chances of securing funding.
