Most significant publications in 2015



- Physical and Theoretical Chemistry
- Medicinal and Organic Chemistry
- Biochemistry and Molecular Biology
- Interdisciplinary (within IOCB)

Each group may submit 1 most significant paper published in 2015 per category, but no more that 2 papers total. Semi-autonomous units within larger groups may submit their own papers if the group leader is not listed as co-author. The papers will be pre-screened internally before they are sent to the external panel (IAB members, ad hoc reviewers) as well as to an internal IOCB panel (group leaders and management). 2 - 4 papers in each category will be awarded prizes in the form of group money.

IOCB PRAGUE Summer students



Purpose: to attract more pregraduates from EU with the aim to have more international PhD students later.

How:

The institute would announce 4-8 possible openings for students of EU countries who are at a stage of one or two years before finishing their master degree.

The openings would be available from July 1st to September 30th each year. The openings would be for 6-8 weeks.

The institute would cover the accommodation and would pay to the students equivalent of 420 € (6 weeks) or 550 € (8 weeks).

- Computational approaches and thermodynamics




